Three cases tested positive at the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS). Two cases reported travel and were identified in a quarantine facility. One case was identified through contact tracing. Of the two travel-related cases, one case reported travel to the US mainland and one case reported travel to the Philippines.

To date, there have been a total of **354** confirmed cases of COVID-19 with **5** deaths, **297** released from isolation, and **52** active cases. Of those cases, **305 are classified as civilians** and **49 are military service members**.
