A total of 25 cases of COVID-19 were confirmed today. Of the 25 newly confirmed cases, four cases were identified through contact tracing and one case reported recent travel from the continental US and was identified in a quarantine facility.

To date, there have been a total of **502** confirmed cases of COVID-19 with **5** deaths, **345** released from isolation, and **152** active cases. Of those cases, **443 are classified as civilians** and **59 are military service members**.
