## [CUI] POSITIVE/CLOSE CONTACT FOR COVID-19

Medical Clearance is required for all personnel who are considered close contact and have been out for more than 3 working days. If you test positive for COVID-19 DPHSS Clearance or doctor's clearance will need to be provided for

> Continue activities and mitigation measures: wash your hands, sanitize, and watch your distance.

1)Stay home/go home until well

- (3) Inform your manager of medical guidance provided.
- (4) Per HRO policy, medical clearance is required for return to work if out sick for 3 days or more.

## **Quarantine Exceptions:**


- Asymptomatic and recently tested positive within 90 days of exposure.
- Asymptomatic and have been fully vaccinated AND received booster.
- Asymptomatic and completed primary doses of Pfizer, Moderna, within the last six months or Johnson and Johnson's vaccine in the last 2 months.

**TERM DEFINITIONS:** 

- \* Fully Vaccinated: Two weeks after second dose of the twodose series (Pfizer-BioNTech and Moderna) or two weeks after the single-dose of Johnson & Johnson's /Janssen vaccine.
- \* Booster: 5 months after the final dose in primary series of Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna vaccine; 2 months after primary dose of Johnson & Johnson/ Jansen vaccine. Must have a minimum of one booster.

### NOTES:

- \*\* If personnel are identified as close contact due to work related exposure, personnel are required to take a COVID-19 test by planning and coordination through DZSP 21.
- \*\* Fever Free: 24 hours have passed with no fever, without the use of fever reducing medication.
